II. Maintenance Reports

A. Dave Heinen, Grounds Maintenance

This summer has brought challenges with irrigation management as we've had to adjust between periods of excessive rainfall and extreme heat. Fortunately, conditions appear to be stabilizing now. Concrete bases have been poured for the new lights at Colonial Court and Verona Circle, which will provide greater stability and make future maintenance easier. The drainage project at Three Trails Island is now complete and performing very well. With the removal of lirioppe, we have replanted the area with vinca minor and made the necessary irrigation adjustments to support its establishment.

The bollard light drawings for Colonial Court have been submitted to the Architectural Review Board (ARB) and are currently under review. All City trees have been planted for the season. Overseeding of the city parks and landscaped islands is scheduled to begin the third week of August to help maintain turf health heading into fall. Lastly, we've had an unusually high amount of poison ivy requiring treatment in several areas this season.

C. Cole Carmack, City Arborist

The summer rains have been beneficial for the trees throughout Mission Hills; however, we are still seeing the effects of **Kermes scale** on some species. Additionally, the increased moisture has created favorable conditions for **mimosa webworm**, particularly on the **honey locust trees** across the City. At **Sunken Gardens**, I completed a more aggressive trimming of the **dappled willow** this season. There is also a **walnut tree** in that area that will likely need to be removed soon due to its condition. Looking ahead, we may consider **pruning several park trees**, as many of them are due for structural maintenance within the next **five years**. Lastly, we plan to **plant approximately 5 -7 additional trees** this fall as part of ongoing projects.
